- * The Spring 2026 Membership chart was updated and emailed to CRC members.

- * META has several reports that can be accessed and downloaded.
- * The Mesa Academic Senate resolutions (2025.12.1 & 2025.12.2) passed.
- * The Mesa Catalog Committee meeting was held on 2/24/26. There have been numerous challenges in getting the digital 2026-27 college catalog accurate. Several new programs may not be listed in the catalog due to the necessity of getting ACCJC approval but they will be listed in the addendum as soon as they have been ACCJC approved. The process for ACCJC approval has recently changed. S. Hess can no longer submit programs to ACCJC for Mesa; they are now being submitted by H. Hoang, Mesa's Dean of Institutional Effectiveness. The next catalog meeting will be on Tues. 3/24/26 at 3 pm via Zoom.
- * Mesa's new Physical Therapist Assistant Bachelor's degree (PTAB) is in the process of being entered into META.
- * J. Kalchik reported that the Policies and Procedures (PnP) committee is working on finalizing a process for adjustments to policies and procedures. Also, there will be a webinar on CORs on March 24, 2026 which will cover adding IDEAA information into CORs.
- * M. Cox reported the Program Review Committee will be meeting on March 6, 2026 and requested CRC members to find someone from their school to serve on the Program Review Committee.
- * Ethnic Studies had no report.
- * Discussion of a process to share District GE with the other campuses is still being planned.
- * Discussion of accepting Credit for Prior Learning continues.
- * There was no Cal-GETC update.
- * C. Kinney reported changes to the Liberal Arts and Sciences: Social and Behavioral Science Studies AA degree are being made.
- * J. Estep reported Mesa is revising the CHEM ADT which now meets the new 66 units template. Mesa is also revising the BIOL ADT to the newly revised template.
- * There was no report on regarding TOP Codes to CIP Codes.

- * There was no report on Outcomes.
- * J. Estep informed the committee the Chancellor's office and state Academic Senate are presenting a webinar on CORs on March 24, 2026 and will cover adding IDEAA information into CORs. A. Svedberg will email members more information on the webinar with the link for registration.

- * Miramar wants to activate City and Mesa's new NAIS 151 course even though they do not have faculty that could teach it. Consensus of the committee is to allow Miramar to activate but recommend against offering the course at this time.
- * J. Estep displayed the Math Sequence chart and it was noted the Prerequisite (New) comment was incorrect. The comment will be corrected.

Estep presented and discussed [District's Attendance Accounting](#) file that shows which Mesa courses that will be affected in order for them to be in compliance with the new Attendance Accounting. Only curricular changes are being reviewed by this committee (for example, changing 0.5-unit EXSC lab hours to match the new standards).
