6. Reports

President Palomino: The Pep Rally was a success, reaching over 13,000 views on Instagram.

Jay: The SETC Committee met a few weeks ago. There will be a Library Pop-Up event today, October 29, from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Additionally, a seminar titled *Undocumented Advocate* will take place next Friday in MC 211. The *Día de Los Muertos* event will be held tomorrow near the Student Health Center.

Omar: There will be a book signing event in MC 211 tomorrow from 11:15 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. featuring a former speechwriter for President Barack Obama.

Sage: Free HIV testing is available at the Pride Center. No updates from the ICC Meeting. The latest newsletter has been sent out.

Victoria: UCSD will host an informational workshop from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in the quad. She also reminded ASG about Mesa Impactship opportunities.

7. Discussion Items

1. *Pep Rally Glows and Grows*

Summer: Suggested beginning preparations for the Pep Rally earlier in the year to allow more time for planning and coordination.

Jay: Noted that the event was highly popular and drew more athletes than expected. He felt it went well overall but became hectic and loud quickly. Recommended notifying ASG earlier before the event and incorporating more games and activities suitable for younger guests.



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President Palomino: Agreed the event was successful overall but emphasized improving coordination regarding member breaks and increasing publicity efforts. Suggested recruiting additional volunteers to ensure smoother transitions between shifts.

Sage: Recommended adjusting the placement of club tents and event signage, ideally finalizing the layout about a month in advance.

Kaylee: Proposed setting up a designated performance area for dancers to ensure visibility and prevent large crowds from blocking the view.

Casey: Encouraged involving more non-athlete participants in future events and suggested extending the Pep Rally by an additional hour.

Ramiah: Supported the idea of including more students while maintaining the Pep Rally's focus on honoring athletics.

Joanna: Proposed creating a Volunteer Committee to assist with organizing and managing future events.

President Palomino: Asked whether all sports were represented at the event, noting that while badminton was present, it was not formally recognized.

Therese: Recommended establishing a volunteer list and improving communication to ensure better coverage during shift changes.

Sage: Mentioned that the Honors Society has its own volunteer program and suggested ASG collaborate with them for future rallies.
